2005/2006 SCHOOL YEAR

Thank you for your interest in Calvary Chapel High School. Below you will find some basic information about our school. Returning students are registered in April and then we assess our class sizes in May before selecting applications. We always have a very high returning student rate. This leaves extremely limited openings for new students and some grade levels may be closed. In some cases, we may be able to accept a student in one grade but not able to accept a sibling in another grade level that is already full. Many applicants will be placed in our waiting file. If openings arise either in the summer or even after school begins in September, we review the waiting files and notify those we can accommodate. We encourage you to apply early and make it a matter of prayer.

Applications & Application Fee: Application fee \$15, per student, maximum \$25 per family (non-refundable). High school applicants must attach a copy of the most current report card and a copy of current high school transcript. Also attach a copy of the most recent SAT9 or CTBS scores (test scores from a previous year are acceptable if the current year is not yet available). Incomplete applications will not be considered. Return the completed application, in person, to the elementary school office (Room 100) and your application fee will be collected at that time.

Notification of Acceptance or Waiting Status: Please apply early and be sure your application is complete and includes all of the following items: student testimony, current report card, student transcript, SAT9 scores, student photo, application fee, and pages 1-2 completed and signed by a parent. We will begin the application review process as soon as we receive your application. To be considered for the first round of acceptances, applications must be received by April 22, and will receive a notification letter May 13, 2005. We receive many applications; you can help the process by turning in your application early. All applications received after April 22 are automatically placed on a waiting status. Applications of students placed on a waiting status will be held on file, in case we are able to enroll additional students, during the summer or after school begins in September.

Open House: All are welcome to visit classrooms at our Open House on Thursday, May 26, 2005, 7:00 p.m.

School Year/Hours: September 6, 2005 - June 15, 2006. 9th-12th grades: 7:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Tuition: Tuition for the 2005/2006 school year will be: Grades K-6 \$3,980, Grades 7-8 \$4,200, **Grades 9-12 \$5,640**. Multiple student discounts are: 2nd student \$500, 3rd student \$1,000, and no tuition charge for the 4th student on. For those who regularly attend and support Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa, we will be offering a Calvary Chapel Costa Mesa family discount of \$500 per student. Tuition is payable in 10 monthly payments due the first of the month, August through May.

Registration: No registration fees are due until after the student is accepted for enrollment. The yearly registration fee of \$350 per student includes student accident insurance, materials, yearbook and curriculum. \$250 is collected on the appointed registration day, and the remaining \$100 is due with the first tuition payment August 1. \$50 of this fee is nonrefundable. No paid portion of this fee is refunded after school begins.

Books: Textbooks and workbooks will be available for purchase from Jubilee Books. This service will buy back used books at the end of the year and will have new and used books available for purchase the following year. Cost will vary depending on classes taken - budget approximately \$250, more for advanced courses.

Car Pools: Parents may submit an information card at registration time. The car pool information cards are indexed by city and then made available to parents to refer to in the elementary school office. Parents may then make their own contacts and arrangements.

Athletics/Extra Curricular: Calvary Chapel High School has a full athletic program. The general athletic fee is \$270 and additional sport fees vary depending upon the sport. The ASB fee (required) is \$80. Programs such as band, drama and various other activities are available. Costs vary.

School Uniforms: Students are required to wear the approved uniform clothing. All uniform pieces must be purchased through the contracted uniform company, True Grits.

Discipline: The school uses a warning/natural consequence/detention system for correcting behavioral problems. Repeat offenders will be sent to administration for prayer and exhortation, and, if necessary, suspension or expulsion from school.

Spiritual Life: Bible study, prayer, and worship are a part of student life at school. Students attend chapel weekly and Bible classes are included in our required classes for graduation. During the school day, students are encouraged to seek the Lord's will in every situation in their lives.
