3. Act and speak in a manner worthy of the God who calls you. Refrain from unkind remarks, profanity, or other language unbecoming a Christian including jokes that may offend is unacceptable. (1 Thessalonians 2:12; Ephesians 4:1 & 5:4)
4. Students are to maintain neat and proper dress. Avoid immodest clothing, extreme hairstyles and make-up. Visible body piercing (except for earrings). Visible tattoos and gang attire are prohibited. (1 Timothy 2:9-10)
5. Respect the property and landscape of those we are visiting. (1 Corinthians 8:7-13, Philippians 2: 3-4; Romans 12:17b)
6. Come to school-sponsored activities prepared to listen attentively with an attitude of learning. Put aside headphones, cell phones or other distracting articles or behavior (James 3:13)
7. Wholesome friendships between boys and girls are encouraged. However, students should refrain from demonstrating personal affections al all school functions. (Galatians 5:24; Romans 12:10; Ephesians 5:3)
